


14. Mr. DeChiaro then stated to Mr. Tegeda that he was aware that Supervisor Cooper put him up to sabotaging his building permits with a stated "farm" use. Mr. Tegeda did not respond, but nodded to acknowledge Mr. DeChiaro's statement.
15. On March 20th, 2008, I was with Mr. DeChiaro and Mr. Adrian Hunte, his attorney at the time, at Yorktown Town court. The appearance was related to alleged wetlands violations.
16. Ms. Hunte explained to us that the Town Environmental Enforcement officer, Mr. Bruce Barber, was instructed by Mr. Nick Bianco to issue Wetlands violations on winery property to aide in halting the winery SLA Permits.
17. Ms. Hunte said that she and Mr. Barber played in golf outing together in the past and because they became friendly he was honest with her regarding the situation with the Winery.
18. While I was working on the project at the winery, there was never any dumping on the property or in the wetlands.
19. Additionally, I attempted to call Mr. Barber on Mr. DeChiaro's behalf at least 6 times. Mr. barber never returned my phone calls.
20. The town clearly was doing everything in their power to prevent Mr. DeChiaro's winery project from opening.
